Introduction

Iran in the world is known for its long history of human civilization. When we say that we Iranians are proud of our history and civilization, the role of scientists from various fields of science and technology, including renowned medical scientists and doctors who are one of the most prominent founders of Iranian and world medical culture, is unconditionally involved. In many countries of the world, Iran is known by the name of its past physicians. However, due to the Iranian cultural intercourse, the victories of the Achaemenid kings of Greece and Rome were opened to Iran, but in any case, some believe that the foundations of medicine and its achievements Iranians have been taken to the West. Historical texts show that the Zoroastrian school existed much earlier than the Greek medical schools. At Zarathustra School, much attention was paid to the health and therapeutic methods. In the years after, Jundishapur University was the world's largest medical reference center for world-class devotees. This has been an honor for the Iranian civilization.
