#### Preface

AGE (Accessible General English) is a book for pre- intermediate and intermediate university students. The book includes fifteen units (twelve lessons plus three review units) to provide enough content for a semesterlong instruction. In fact, readings are Internet based and have mainly included the new and interesting topics and have noticed the interests of the students. It has been tried to put texts with various topics and cor ent. including psychology, nutrition, technology, sociology, business, physicingy, earth science, biography, architecture, culture, geography and provides.
