## Introduction

*'Street fighting in Petersburg! The soldiers have joined the rebels! It's the Revolution!'*

It is the beginning of the twentieth century and the lives of four young people are interrupted by the extraordinary events of the Russian Revolution. They struggle to define their role in a constantly changing world, just as their country searches for its way forward. Each of the four – Yury, Tonya, Lara and Sasha – finds love and loses it, faces the endless problems caused by the Revolution, and comes to a better understanding of who they are. They are surrounded by a crowd of unusual, often tragic figures whose personal histories mirror his formative period in Russia's history.

Boris Pasternak was born in Moscow in 1890. His father was a painter and his mother a concert pianist and he grew up in a world of music and literature. He originally studied music but gave it up to write poems when he was eighteen. His third book of poems, *My Sister Life*, made him famous. Pasternak wrote stories as well as poems during the 1920s and 1930s. He was not accepted as an official 'Soviet writer', however, and none of his works was printed between 1933 and 1943. During that time he made his living as a translator. *Dr Zhivago* is Pasternak's greatest work. The government did not allow it to be printed in the USSR, but it appeared in Italy in 1957 and won the Nobel Prize for Literature in 1958. Because of his problems with the Soviet government, Pasternak did not accept the prize. Pasternak lived most of his life in Moscow and died in 1960.
