Introduction

This book is the output of my years of teaching in Kashan University, Azad University of Karaj, and TOEFL preparation classes. The vocabulary courses in universities present a challenge for teachers. They often take vocabulary exercises to classes which fail to engage the interest of students, because the classes soon change to the mechanical process of doing exercises. Alternatively, they choose as coursebooks one of those books available in the market like Word Power Made Easy " or " Essential Words for TOEFL". I did either of the above with no useful results. Finally I decided to work with roots, prefixes and suffixes. It did work miracles; students showed a lot of interest and enthusiasm. Knowing that "aspect" means "look", they were pleased to be able to guess the meanings of "spectator", "spectacles", "inspect", "retrospect", "introspect", "prospective" and other words. I have dedicated a good portion of the book to roots. Of secondary importance are prefixes, and suffixes. All three have been dealt with in alphabetical order. I am well aware that Dr Tajvidi has done a similar job for Pyame-noor University. But my work specifically meets the needs of TOEFL and MA exam candidates. As was discussed it can be legitimately used in vocabulary courses in BA programs. A separate section has been dedicated to idioms. The last section deals with tests based on "1100 Words".
